We have our art exhibition next week Wednesday 11th September from 3pm until 4.30pm in the school hall, Thursday 12th September from 6pm until 7.30pm. We run the evening session to allow working parents to be able to come and enjoy the artwork. We want to see as many families as we can for this event, there is no charge for entry, so bring the whole family!

We have a policy around mobile devices in the classroom during school time. We are also aware of mobile phones being kept in bags. For the safety of the devices, with bags often being left on the ground, we are asking for these to now be handed into the office and having consulted with local schools, we have made the call that this also now includes watches with the capability to make calls or send and receive texts. These devices may be brought to school, for use after school etc, but they will be required to be handed in to Judi or Helena in the office before school starts, where they will be put in a locked box to be collected at the end of the day. If the child forgets, they will be asked to go to the office to hand these in. These items will need to be named (or in a named bag) so we can ensure the right watch or phone is returned. We will enact this from Monday. We appreciate your support in this.

We have used the sign in tablet at the office for a little while now, and we are pleased that people sign in and out efficiently. It is vital that if your child is leaving for an appointment that they are signed out and back in. Please come to the office first, and we can send for your child to come and meet you at the office, while you sign them out, hopefully saving you some time.

It is also vital that we know who is on site, for health and safety reasons, such as a lock down or fire. With this in mind, we have now a label system, similar to most other schools. This helps us to identify who is on site at any time and if they have signed in. We ask if you are visiting the school to help in a classroom, etc, that you come and sign in. This process will also include contractors, tradespeople and visiting teachers taking a visitors label to wear.

Today I really want to acknowledge our amazing FOGS group and just mention a few things that they are doing at the moment. Firstly tomorrow we have our disco night. The tickets are on the door and we look forward to seeing as many children as we can for this fun night. This is totally organised by the FOGS team and without their organisation and the support of parent volunteers, we wouldn't be able to offer these great experiences for our children.

We have also had our Father's Day market last week, and I'd like to thank our awesome Enterprise Group, who worked hard to get this organised, again the FOGS supported this and this raised over \$2000 for our school and children. You will have noticed the TVs we have in the rooms now, we have just got four more and these are key learning tools for the classroom. The funding for these has come from the fundraising efforts of our FOGS group.
